Veterans Memorial Monument - Finalize the Language on the Memorial

DISCUSSION:

On August 23, 2022, the City Commission met with representatives from the American Legion Post 120 and the DAV Post 84 to discuss the language to be engraved into the stones of the Veterans Memorial Monument.

Below is the language that was agreed to that evening. City staff is seeking direction confirming the language to be sent to the designer for production.

FRONT:

Center Stone:

In memory of our Holly Hill Veterans who sacrificed their lives in service for their Country. Add list of names with Branch, birth and death dates.

Military logos must be in this order from left to right:

Left Stone: U.S. Army, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Navy,
Right Stone: U.S. Air Force, U.S. Space Force, U.S. Coast Guard

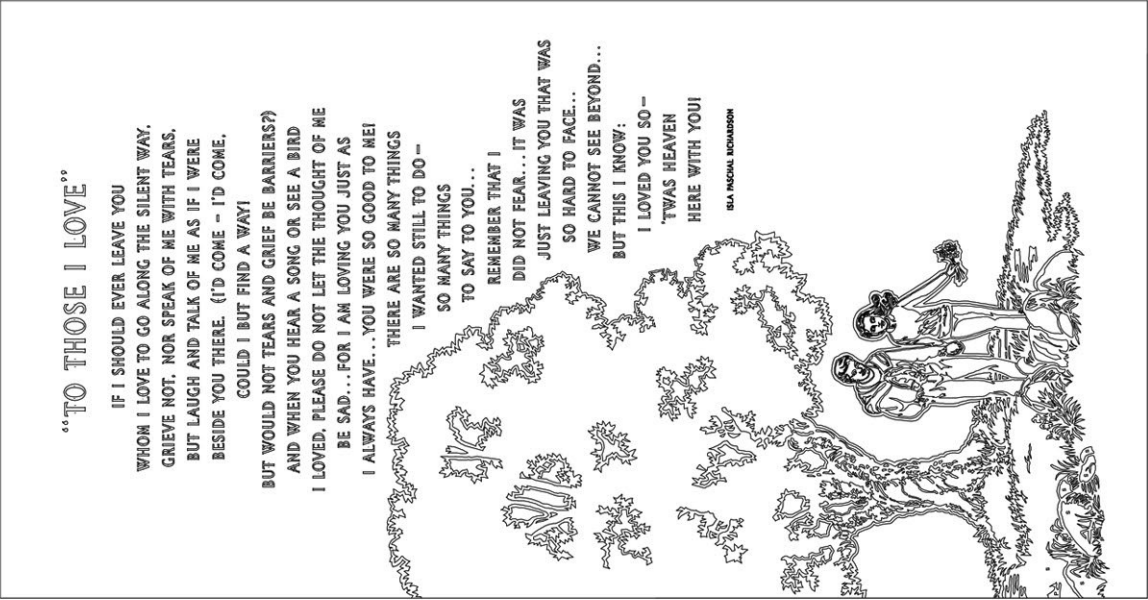
Direction is needed if the monument will have the Merchant Marine logo engraved in it. There is one veteran, Lost at Sea, from the Merchant Marines on the list of names provided to the City.

REAR:

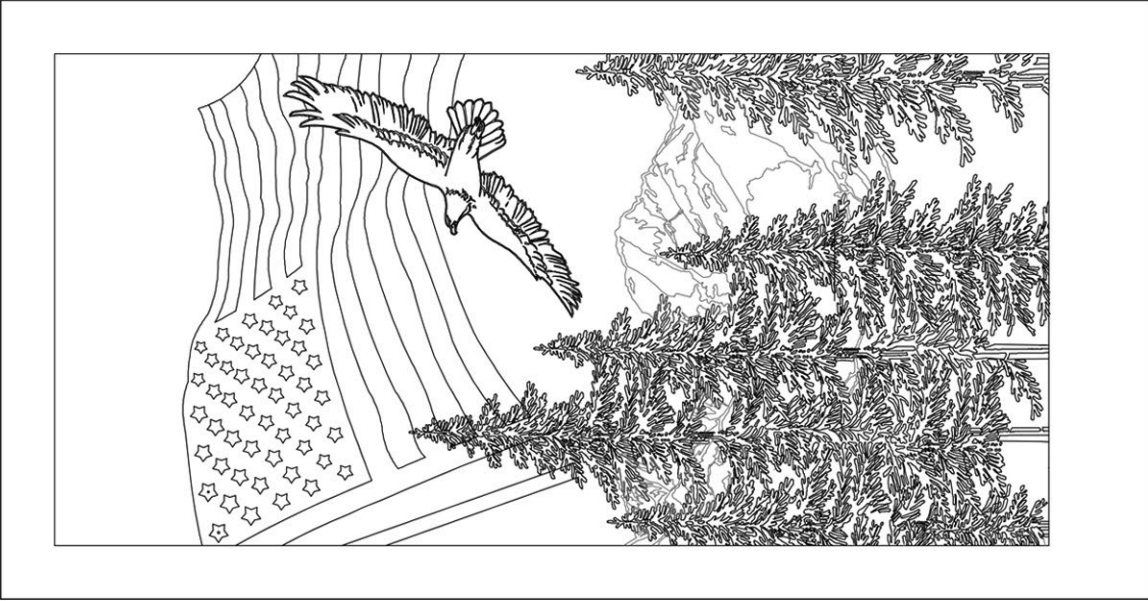
Left Stone -Eagle. (All gave some, some gave all) Howard William Osterkam

Center Stone - American Flag (Our flag does not fly because the wind moves it. It flies with the last breath of each soldier who dies protecting it) Unknown

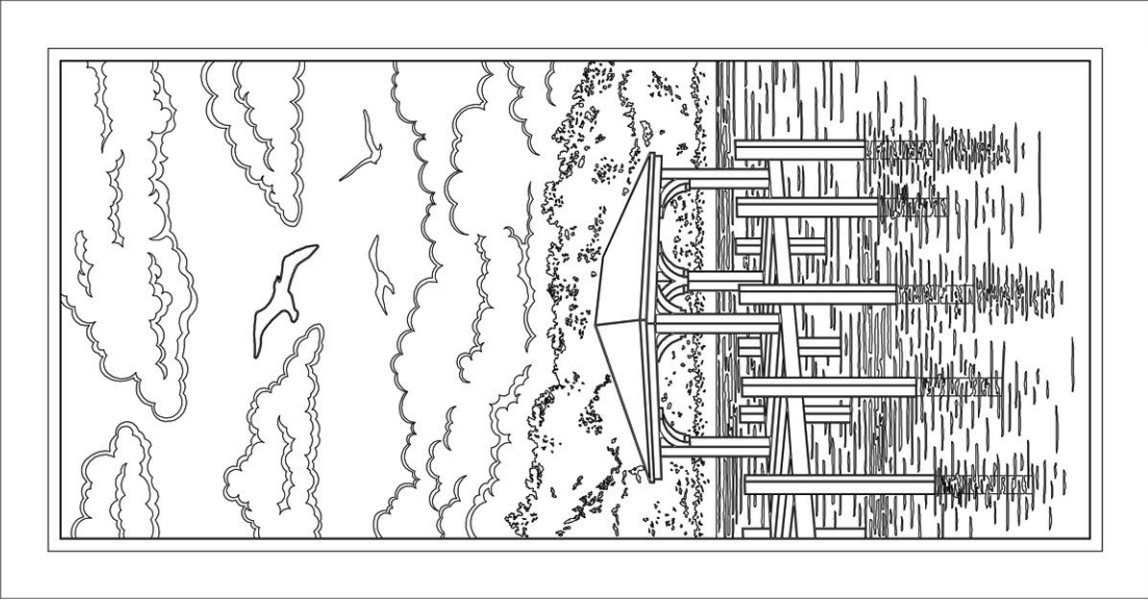
Right Stone - POW- MIA Seal (You are not forgotten)

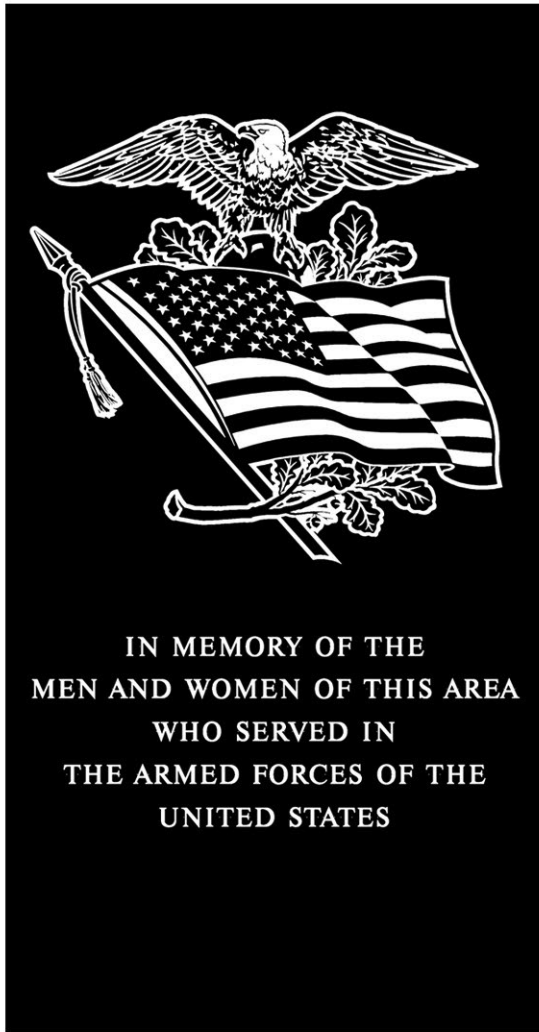

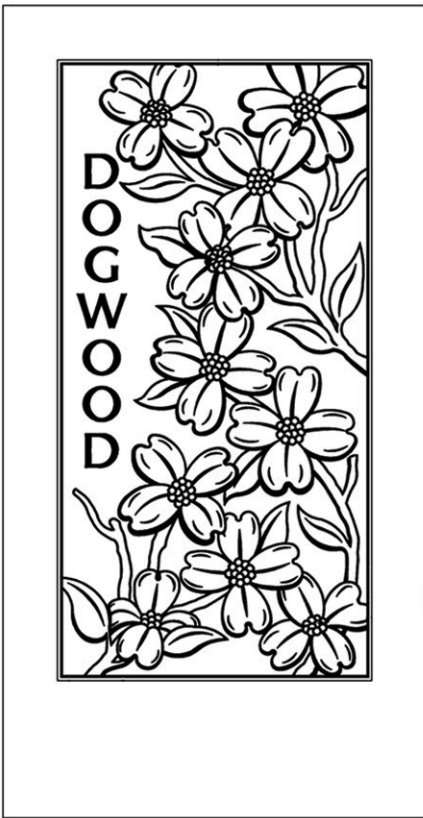

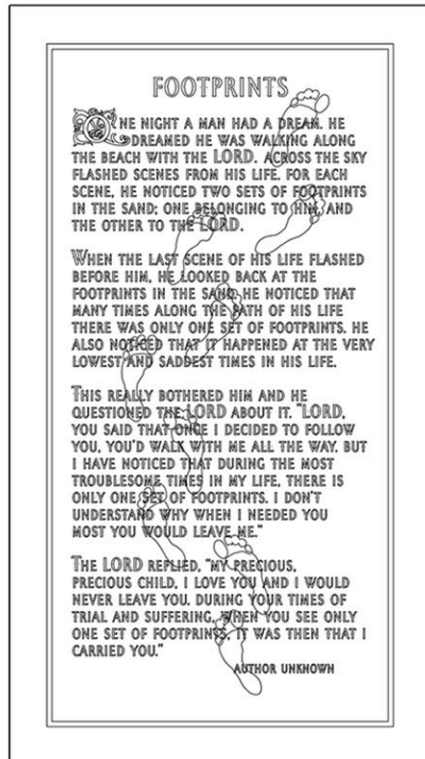

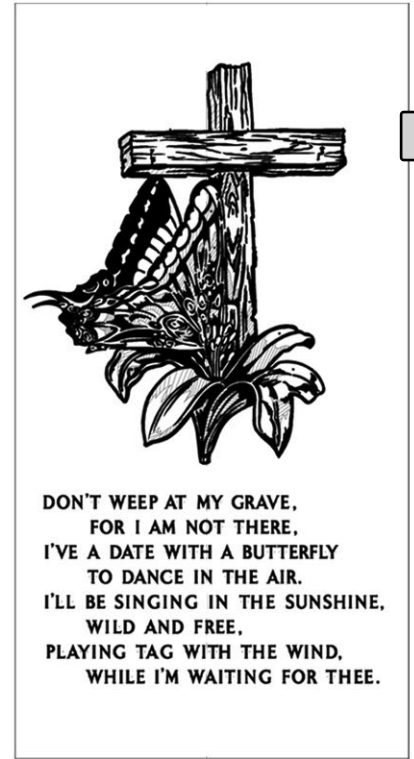
