

**MINUTES
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA
OCTOBER 14, 1996**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor William D. Arthur called the meeting to order in Conference Room 227 at City Hall, 1065 Ridgewood Avenue at 7:30 p.m..

Answering roll call were Mayor Arthur, Councilman Arthur Byrnes, Councilman J. D. Mellette, Councilman Shirley Heyman and Councilman Jim Elliott.

Also attending were City Manager Donald Lusk and Deputy City Clerk Sue W. Blackwell.

2. CONSIDERATION/PURCHASE OF RECYCLE TRUCK

Mr. Hallman explained there were three trucks available for \$15,000 each if all three were purchased or the price is \$18,000 if purchased individually. He said he would like authorization to spend up to \$18,000 for a truck. If this request is approved, two of the City's men will go to Ft. Myers to check the truck before the City makes a firm decision on it.

Council talked about why these trucks were on the market and Mr. Hallman said that private firms such as Waste Management change their equipment on a regular basis and that is why these trucks are available for purchase.

Councilman Heyman moved to APPROVE the request being seconded by Councilman Mellette. The motion CARRIED 5-0 on roll call.

Council told Mr. Hallman to make sure his men check this equipment carefully.

3. ADJOURNMENT

There was no further business to come before the Council so the meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:38 p.m.
