SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA
NOVEMBER 16, 1993

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Jim Gaither called the meeting to order in Council Chambers, 1065 Daytona Avenue, Holly Hill, Fl. at 8:00 p.m..

Answering roll call were Mayor Gaither, Councilman Arthur Byrnes, Councilman J. D. Mellette, Councilman Robert Chesnowitz and Councilman William Walker.

Also attending were City Manager Ralph Hester, City Attorney Edward Simpson and Connie Wines, Recording Secretary.

2. CANVASS ELECTION RETURNS

Mayor Gaither called a recess at 8:01 p.m. to await the election results.

The meeting was brought back to order at 9:15 p.m.

City Attorney Simpson read:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 1993, IN THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL SEAT POSITIONS OF WARD THREE (3) AND WARD FOUR (4); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. The City Council has duly canvassed the returns in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida and the Charter of the City of Holly Hill and finds the results of said election to be as follows:

Qualifying candidates for the office of Mayor are:

1) James Gaither	Received	<u>465</u>	votes	<u>33.7</u>	%
2) Doug Kneller	Received	<u>356</u>	votes	<u>25.8</u>	%
3) Virginia Wine	Received	<u>536</u>	votes	<u>38.8</u>	%

Qualifying candidates for the Ward 3 Council Seat are:

- 1) Robert Chesnowitz Received 474 votes 34.3 %
- 2) Shirley Heyman Received 547 votes 39.6 %
- 3) Charles King Received 272 votes 19.7 %

Qualifying candidates for the Ward 4 Council Seat are:

- 1) James Elliott Received 442 votes 32.0 %
- 2) Calvin Fink Received 269 votes 19.5 %
- 3) William Walker Received 560 votes 40.6 %

Section 2. If one of the candidates receives fifty percent plus one of the votes cast, said candidate shall be declared elected for that particular office. If no one receives fifty percent plus one of the votes cast, then the top two vote recipients will have a run-off in the General Election to be held Tuesday, December 7, 1993.

Councilman Mellette moved to ADOPT Resolution 93-R-58 as read being seconded by Councilman Chesnowitz.

The motion CARRIED 5-0 on the following roll call:

Mellette, yes; Chesnowitz, yes; Walker, yes; Byrnes, yes;
Gaither, yes.

3. ADJOURNMENT

With nothing further to come before Council the meeting was adjourned at 9:22 p.m.
