SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA
DECEMBER 7, 1993

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Jim Gaither called the meeting to order in Council Chambers, 1065 Daytona Avenue, Holly Hill, Fl. at 8:00 p.m..

Answering roll call were Mayor Gaither, Councilman Arthur Byrnes, Councilman J. D. Mellette, Councilman Robert Chesnowitz and Councilman William Walker.

Also attending were City Manager Ralph Hester, City Attorney Edward Simpson and Connie Wines, Recording Secretary.

2. RESOLUTION DECLARING THE GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS

Mayor Gaither called a recess at 8:01 p.m. to await the election results.

The meeting was brought back to order at 8:50 p.m.

City Attorney Simpson read:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 7, 1993, IN THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL SEAT POSITIONS OF WARD ONE (1), TWO (2), THREE (3), AND FOUR (4); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, two (2) candidates have qualified for each of the following offices: Mayor, Councilman of Ward One (1), Councilman of Ward Two (2), Councilman of Ward Three (3) and Councilman of Ward Four (4); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 151 of the Charter of the City of

Holly Hill, a general election must be held to determine which candidate receives the largest number of votes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City Council has duly canvassed the returns in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida and the Charter of the City of Holly Hill and finds the results of said election to be as follows:

Qualifying candidates for the office of Mayor are:

- 1) Jim Gaither Received 652 votes
- 2) Virginia Wine Received 750 votes

Virginia Wine is the declared winner for the office of Mayor of the City of Holly Hill.

Qualifying candidates for the Ward 1 Council Seat are:

- 1) Arthur Byrnes Received 661 votes
- 2) Lois Willett Received 628 votes

Arthur Byrnes is the declared winner for the Ward 1 Council Seat of the City of Holly Hill.

Qualifying candidates for the Ward 2 Council Seat are:

- 1) J.D. Mellette Received 714 votes
- 2) Pearl Ward Received 567 votes

J.D. Mellette is the declared winner for the Ward 2 Council Seat of the City of Holly Hill.

Qualifying candidates for the Ward 3 Council Seat are:

- 1) Robert Chesnowitz Received 613 votes
- 2) Shirley Heyman Received 750 votes

Shirley Heyman is the declared winner for the Ward 3 Council Seat of the City of Holly Hill.

Qualifying candidates for the Ward 4 Council Seat are:

- 1) Jim Elliott Received 699 votes
- 2) William Walker Received 614 votes

Jim Elliott is the declared winner for the Ward 4 Council Seat of the City of Holly Hill.

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of the Resolution, or application hereof, is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court, such portion or application shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or application thereof.

Section 3. That all resolutions made in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The within and foregoing Resolution was read before the City Council of the City of Holly Hill, Florida, at its regular meeting held in council chambers at Sica Hall, 1065 Daytona Avenue, Holly

Hill, Florida, on the 7th day of December, A.D. 1993.

It was moved by Councilman Walker and seconded by Councilman Mellette that said Resolution be adopted. A roll call vote of the Council on said motion of the Resolution resulted as follows:

Councilman Walker moved to ADOPT Resolution 93-R-61 being seconded by Councilman Mellette.

The motion CARRIED 5-0 on the following roll call:

Walker, yes; Mellette, yes; Chesnowitz, yes; Byrnes, yes; Gaither, yes.

With nothing further to come before Council the meeting was adjourned at 9:01 p.m.
