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COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY MEETING
CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA
MAY 8, 2001

1. CALL TO ORDER - Roll Call

Mayor William Arthur called the meeting to order in the Commission Chambers at City Hall, 1065 Ridgewood Avenue at approximately 6:48 p.m. Attending with Mayor Arthur were Commissioners Arthur Byrnes, Paul Lockeby, Keith Tarrer and Roland Via.

Also attending were City Manager Joe Forte, Finance Director Brenda Gubernator, Assistant to the City Manager Greg Wood, and City Clerk Jeaneen Clauss.

2. EXPANSION OF THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA

Mr. Forte explained that the purpose of this meeting is to have the Community Redevelopment Authority (which is the City Commission) accept the recommendation of the Community Redevelopment Advisory Board to expand the Community Redevelopment Area to the City's northern limits. They would then recommend this action to the City Commission. He utilized the overhead projector to show the properties they were proposing to add. This proposal is being made to include recently annexed properties into the City.

Mention was made of the unincorporated property in the midst of the City, which is only shy of being an enclave because of its connection to Ridgewood Avenue. The City is currently seeking to annex this area.

*Commissioner Tarrer moved **APPROVAL** of recommending to the City Commission that the Community Redevelopment Area be expanded to the northern City Limits, seconded by Commissioner Lockeby.*

The motion **CARRIED** 5-0 on the following roll call: Tarrer – yes, Lockeby – yes, Byrnes – yes, Via – yes, Arthur – yes.

3. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting officially adjourned at approximately 6:52 p.m.
