

**MINUTES
SPECIAL COMMISSION MEETING
CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA
JUNE 02, 1998**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor William D. Arthur called the meeting to order in Commission Chambers at City Hall, 1065 Ridgewood Avenue at approximately 7:07 p.m.

Answering roll call were Mayor Arthur, Commissioners Arthur Byrnes, J. D. Mellette, Shirley Heyman and Roland Via.

Also attending were City Manager Donald Lusk, Assistant City Attorney Scott Simpson, and Deputy City Clerk Susie Sheets.

2. SPECIAL BUSINESS

Mayor Arthur said the Special Called Meeting is to ratify the LIUNA Contract.

Assistant City Attorney Simpson read:

RESOLUTION 98-R-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL AND THE LABORERS INTERNATIONAL UNION OF NORTH AMERICA, LOCAL 678, AFL-CIO (LIUNA); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

City Manager Lusk said, "The raises would start at the next effective payroll and will start at the beginning of the new pay period. This is a contract that does not get ratified by the Union. The Commission imposes the five impasse articles and ratifies the twenty articles already agreed upon. You are ratifying the whole contract."

Commissioner Byrnes said, "It was a very long document, I received it yesterday morning, I want to make it clear on the record that I am voting for what we talked about at the last meeting and there are no changes from what we've talked about then."

City Manager Lusk said, "The only change, and it wasn't a change, is the effective date. I'm asking you to go back to last Friday to start the pay raises which is typical of our past contracts."

*Commissioner Mellette moved to **ADOPT** Resolution 98-R-20 being seconded by Commissioner Heyman. The motion **CARRIED** 5-0 on the following roll call:*

Mellette, yes; Heyman, yes; Byrnes, yes; Via, yes; Arthur, yes.
